

WHAT IS ADOPT-A-STOP?

Adopt-A-Stop is a partnership between SMART and community volunteers to help make the city's bus stops safer and cleaner. Local individuals, businesses and civic organizations are encouraged to do their part by "adopting" a bus stop. You can make a positive difference for your community!

Adopting a stop helps you:

- Contribute to the appearance of your neighborhood.
- Create and maintain a clean, safe and secure bus stop for all riders.
- · Generate community pride and receive public recognition for your efforts.

HOW IT WORKS

Individuals, businesses and organizations who Adopt-A-Stop commit to improving bus stops by volunteering to take on regular maintenance tasks.

Maintenance Partner: Your responsibilities as a Maintenance partner for one (1) year may include:

- Keeping your adopted bus stop(s)/shelter(s) clean, litter free and clear of ice and snow.
- · Alerting SMART about vandalism, graffiti or other problems.
- Landscaping the area around the stop if you are able to maintain the landscaping.
 (Consult SMART for specific guidelines.)

ADOPT-A-STOP PARTNER BENEFITS

- Signage at the adopted bus stop recognizing your organization or business as the Adopt-A-Stop partner.
- · A welcome kit with supplies and materials to help you get started.
- Recognition in social media and press materials.
- Sponsor recognition to display at your organization.
- Improving the city aesthetics and the satisfaction of knowing you are making your community a better place.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Individuals, community organizations, local businesses, public agencies, churches, schools, school groups, civic organizations, scout groups, fraternities/sororities and others!

IS THERE A COST TO BECOME AN ADOPT A STOP PARTNER?

There is no cost to become a partner, however there is cost for supplies to help maintain the bus stop (trash bags, etc.).
